## Farmers' Market Shares!

### How does it work?

Just pay for your share in the spring and receive a credit for the amount you paid plus an extra \$50 (full share) or \$15 (half share) to spend at any time during our growing season (April – November). We attend two farmers' markets each week and invite customers to our on-farm pick-up on Fridays from 4:00 to 6:00 PM.

### What else do you get?

In addition to the extra \$50 or \$15 credit, you'll receive:

- **\*NEW\* for 2012:** the benefit of optional home delivery (cost to be subtracted from total credit);
- **\*NEW\* for 2012:** a Sugar Creek Farm cloth grocery tote;
- the exclusive right to reserve produce for pick-up at your convenience during one of the markets or at the farm;
- a newsletter including farm notes, what we'll be selling that week and recipes; and
- an invitation to our Farm Share Member Appreciation Day with great music, food and an opportunity to see behind-the-scenes!

### Why sign up?

The best feature of the Farmers' Market Share is that unlike a conventional CSA, you choose what you want and when, not us. Come to the market on your own schedule, pick out the items you want, and we'll subtract it from your total credit. So if we grow something you don't like, don't buy it! Forgot your wallet? No problem! Going out of town? No need to find someone to pick up your share; just double up the next week. It's totally up to you.

### Where Can You Pick-Up Your Produce?

You'll find Sugar Creek Farm from April through November at:

**The Farm** on Friday evenings from 4:00 PM until 6:00 PM. Bring friends and family and come check out where your food is grown.

**The Dixie Classic Fairgrounds Farmers' Market** on Saturdays from 6:00 AM until 12:00 PM. People always say to come early for the best choice, but if you're a member we'll hold your goods for you so you can sleep in! At this market you can find all kinds of vegetables, meat, baked goods, crafts, transplants, etc. Open all year, located off 27<sup>th</sup> Street and University Parkway (near LJVM Coliseum).

**The Cobblestone Market** on Tuesdays from 10:00 AM until 1:00 PM. This market is located in downtown Winston-Salem near the intersection of Third Street and Patterson Avenue. All growers at this market have been inspected to ensure that they use sustainable practices, and you can't sell it if you don't grow it! For sale are vegetables, meat, cheese, eggs, baked goods, and other items that vary from week to week.

The cost of a full share is \$400 (for which you'll be credited \$450) OR you can also choose a half share for \$200 (for which you'll be credited \$215). Please make checks out to Sugar Creek Farm.
